The Society of American Military Engineers is once again coordinating "Day with an Engineer" (DWE) as a key component of Engineer's Week. This event is scheduled for **Wednesday, February 21, 2018**. The purpose of the event is to allow high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to gain an understanding of engineering and scientific disciplines by working side by side with experienced professionals. It is requested that each firm participate by hosting **two or more** students for one day. During DWE, members of your firm shall provide students with the opportunity to be actively involved in a variety of engineering and scientific activities, such as brainstorming, design, and execution of a client deliverable with a project team. Last year we had a good turn out and excellent feedback from over 40 highly motivated students and 9 generous firms who donated their time and efforts and this year, we will again:

- Require students who participate to be nominated by their teachers, counselors, or principals and each student must complete an application form to ensure interest and dedication.
- Utilize information provided by you and the students to make sure students interests are appropriately matched with each firm's capabilities.
- Recognize participating firms at SAME meetings and in the newsletter (FREE Advertising!)

As in years past, we are again looking for firms ready and willing to volunteer their time and facilities to make the 2018 event a success. To step up and volunteer, we ask you to fill out the accompanying form on the back and return it to the address(es) listed as soon as possible.

We are continually trying to improve this program and this year we would like to build on the 2017 program. For this year's event, we would like to give to each of the student participants a T-shirt commemorating the event and their participation as a reminder of what they were involved in.
